

Sounding the Tribulation Trumpet

*Building a 7-Year Timeline for the End Times
2025-2032*

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Preface

To whomever has received this document, whether from myself personally, a friend or family member of yours, or through a post on the internet, I pray that it may be a blessing to you.

I write this document to prepare you for what is to come in the near future or, if you are reading this at a later time, to explain what has happened and what you should do now. Before I get into the details, I will first share my background and why I am writing this document at the current time during August 2025.

I have been particularly drawn to the biblical prophecies of the end times since I was a child. Even in elementary school, I would wake up before church on Sundays to read the Book of Revelation. Although I couldn't understand what I was reading, I was still captivated by it. I would even use Revelation as inspiration for some of the art I would make later on in high school.

Years later in the Spring of 2014, my interest in the end times changed from being casual to serious once I learned that the Rapture and Jesus' 2nd Coming could be much sooner than I had realized. I began to study the biblical prophecies constantly and kept watch for different signs that were linked to the coming end. I also connected with many other watchmen online and kept a close eye on dreams and visions shared by others to see if God was revealing anything that could help narrow down the timeframe for the Rapture.

It has now been about 11.5 years since I started watching and many dates that were possible candidates for the Rapture have come and gone. Although world events seemed to be progressing towards the end time prophecies step by step, the progression always felt slower than I thought it would be. This caused me to become increasingly relaxed when it came to watching for the Rapture. I kept mostly silent, hardly sharing anything with loved ones because I did not feel any serious urgency. However, everything changed in June 2025.

A brother in Christ named Joshua from South Africa came forward at that time with a testimony that Jesus Himself appeared before him and told him that the Rapture would happen on the Feast of Trumpets on September 23-24, 2025 and that His 2nd Coming would occur on the Day of Atonement on September 15, 2032. This drove the entire watchmen community into a frenzy because no one had ever come forward before with such a definitive timeframe for the end.

Many people denounced Joshua as a false prophet, but hundreds of people also came forward with testimonies about their dreams and visions confirming that Joshua was telling the truth. I myself was very skeptical at first, but I had never seen such a massive influx of dreams and visions from people agreeing on a specific timeframe, prompting me to start testing the timeframe against the biblical prophecies to see if they matched. To my amazement, the timeframe Joshua provided seemed to match the prophecies *exactly*. With so much evidence backing up the timeframe that this brother in Christ shared, I have become convinced that this timeframe is correct and that the Rapture is finally about to happen.

Because of this realization, I have decided to break my silence and warn as many people as I can about what is coming and explain how to prepare. To do so, I must first share the evidence for why I believe the timeframe that Joshua provided is true so that others may believe as well and heed my warnings.

I hope that by the time you finish reading this document, you will also feel the urgency of the Rapture and Jesus Christ's return. If you are a Christian, I pray that you begin to reevaluate and reflect on your relationship with Christ and repent of any sins that you may still indulge in. Renew your relationship with Him with a newfound fire and passion in preparation for His return. If you are not a Christian, I hope you know that Jesus loves you, that He lived a perfect life, that He died for you as a perfect sacrifice on the cross, all so that your sins could be forgiven before God. Believe in Him, repent of your sins, and follow Him, and you will be granted eternal life in His presence.

For the Christian who has just found Jesus, I implore you to turn from your old life of sin and draw close to Jesus through reading His Word and prayer. He will prepare you for what is to come.

For those who have not yet found Jesus, know that He loves you, is calling out to you, and is waiting for you to come to Him. He alone can save you from what is to come. He is our only hope and the only way to salvation.

For everyone who is reading this, I pray that you go into this with an open heart and mind, and seek the Holy Spirit for discernment.

Overview

The following document will make the case for the overall timeline of the end times, including the Rapture during the Feast of Trumpets on September 23-24, 2025, a possible 2nd Rapture during Passover week around April 5, 2029, and the 2nd Coming of Jesus during the Day of Atonement on September 15, 2032. It will also briefly show how the events of Revelation will play out in relation to this timeline.

In addition, this document will include extremely important warnings about events that are to come. These events include the coming alien deception that will be used to explain away the Rapture as something else, as well as the coming of the Mark of the Beast.

By reading and understanding this document, I hope that people will either prepare themselves to meet Jesus in the Rapture or be able to understand what has happened and what will happen in the future if they miss the Rapture.

I have attempted to make this document as simple to read and as easy to follow as possible in case you are not familiar at all with the prophecies of the Bible. I highly recommend reading this document with a Bible available to reference.

The Rapture and 2nd Coming of Jesus

The concepts of the Rapture and the 2nd Coming of Jesus are generally known, but not many people truly understand them from the perspective of bible prophecy. It is important to know the meaning, significance, and differences between the two.

The Rapture is a global event during which true believers and followers of Jesus are given immortal bodies, caught up to meet Jesus above the earth, and then taken to heaven, all in the

blink of an eye. This event is described in many Bible verses, particularly in Matthew 24:29-31, 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17, and 1 Corinthians 15:51-52. God takes these people to heaven in order to protect them from the judgment that he will unleash on the earth afterwards. Although most people who study bible prophecy see only one rapture event in the scriptures, I believe that the Bible shows two different rapture events. To keep this document a manageable length, I will not make my case for that here. Just keep this in mind for later.

The 2nd Coming of Jesus is the event where Jesus returns physically to the earth, destroys the Antichrist, and establishes His 1000-year reign. Bible passages related to this event include Zechariah 14:1-8 and Revelation 19:11-21. Note that this event is NOT the same as the Rapture as many people may believe.

The Fig Tree Generation

The parable of the fig tree provides a general timeframe during which the events of the end time must occur. Jesus gave this parable in Matthew 24:

“Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh: So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. Verily I say unto you, this generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.” (Matthew 24:32-34)

Biblically, the fig tree is used as a symbol of Israel. Through this parable, Jesus is saying that the events of the end times must happen by a certain time. Specifically, these events must occur during the generation that is born with the rebirth of Israel as a nation.

In the modern time, Israel was reborn on May 14, 1948. The Bible specifies that a generation is 70-80 years (Psalms 90:10), therefore it can be inferred that the events must initiate before Israel turns 81 years old, which will be in May of 2029.

Using this timeframe as a guide, we know the events will begin very soon. However, this leaves the question of “how soon”, and whether we can pinpoint a more specific window of time.

Definition of a “Day” in the Bible

To understand the Bible’s explanation of timeframes, it’s important to understand that a day can mean multiple things in Scripture.

A day can mean a literal 24-hour day, such as Jesus rising on the third day. In this case, it means that he rose on the literal third day as we understand it.

A day can also mean a year, as God illustrated in Numbers and Ezekiel:

“After the number of the days in which ye searched the land, even forty days, each day for a year, shall ye bear your iniquities, even forty years, and ye shall know my breach of promise.” (Numbers 14:34)

“And when thou hast accomplished them, lie again on thy right side, and thou shalt bear the iniquity of the house of Judah forty days: I have appointed thee each day for a year.” (Ezekiel 4:6)

A day can also mean a thousand years, as illustrated in 2 Peter:

“But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.” (2 Peter 3:8)

In order to correctly understand certain prophecies in the Bible, we need to apply a flexible understanding of what a day means.

The 360-Day Prophetic Year

We also need to understand there are three different ways to count years.

In the modern world, we use the solar year, which is approximately 365.25 days.

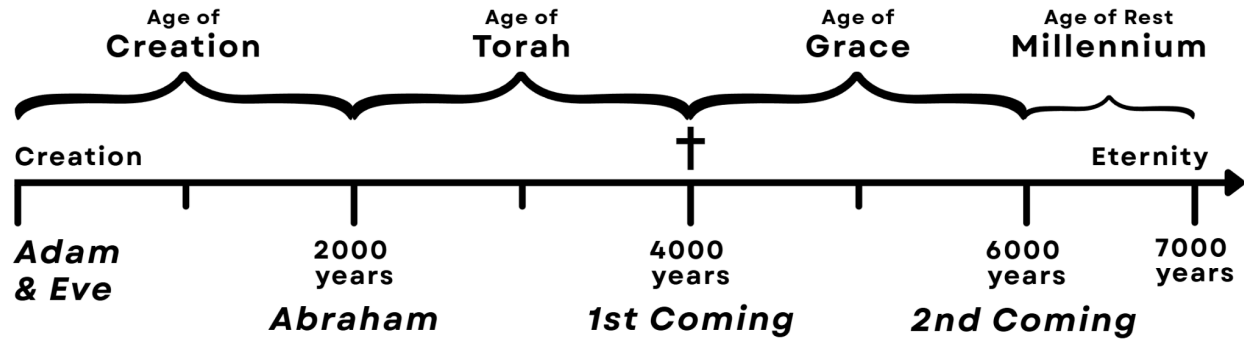
You can also count years based on the lunar cycle, which is approximately 357.37 days. This is what the Jews use for their calendar.

The Bible also refers to a prophetic year of 360 days, which is referenced multiple times throughout Scripture such as in Daniel and Revelation. This understanding will be important for forming a timeline later on, so keep this in mind.

God's 7000-Year Plan for Mankind

To get a big picture understanding of biblical prophecy, we must first understand that God has a 7000-year plan for mankind.

The Jews have long understood God's 7000-year plan, which they divided into 3.5 ages. They referred to the first three ages as the Age of Creation, the Age of Torah, and the Age of Grace, which were 2000 years each. The final age is 1000 years long, totaling to 7000 years.



Interestingly, the 7000 years can be viewed akin to the seven days of creation in Genesis, whereas the final 1000 years can be understood as an “Age of Rest,” mirroring the Sabbath. Just as written in 2 Peter 3:8, **“one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.”**

The Bible speaks of this “Age of Rest” as Jesus’s 1000-year reign. Revelation 20:4-6 refers to the 1000 years multiple times, indicating that **“they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.”**

Hosea 6:2 can also be understood as a reference to the 3.5 ages: **“After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight.”** The two days are the Age of Grace and the third day is the 1000-year reign.

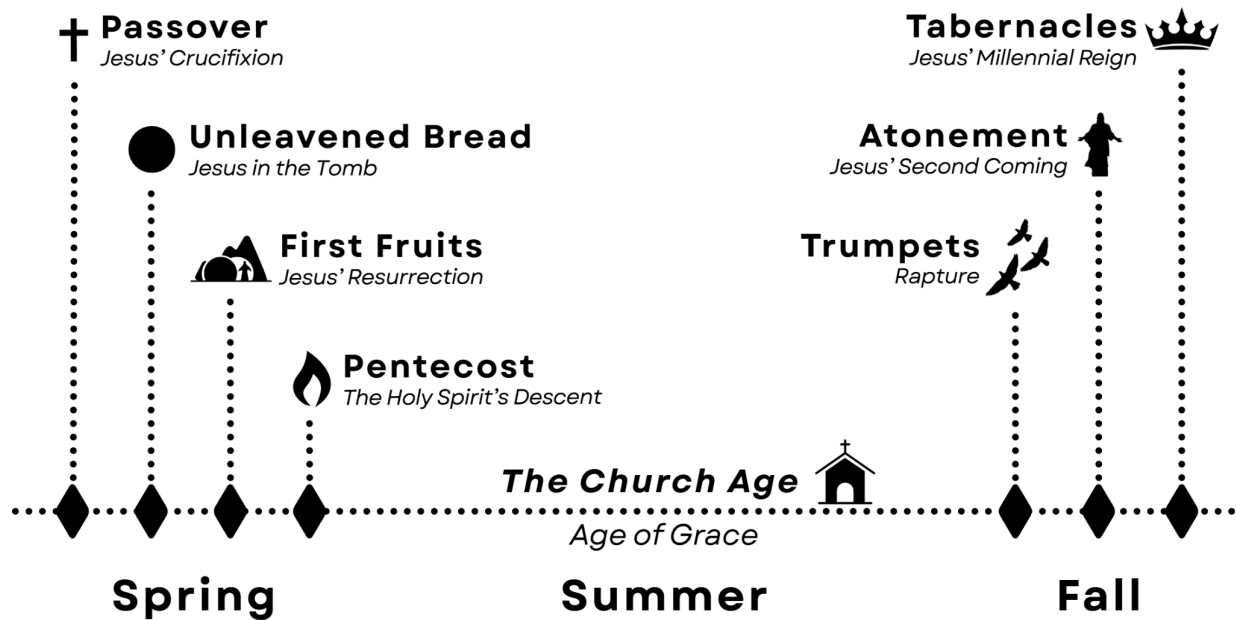
The takeaway is that we understand there are 2000 years between Christ’s 1st Coming and 2nd Coming.

7 Feasts of God

The 7 feasts of God show us when He has planned important prophetic events to occur.

In Leviticus 23, God conveyed these 7 feasts to Moses, which the Jews continue to observe to this day. In Hebrew, the word for feasts is *moedim*, which translates literally to *appointed times*. The purpose of these feasts was to function as a “dress rehearsal” that the Israelites would practice every year in preparation for the future fulfillment of the true events they represented.

THE 7 FEASTS OF GOD



Christ fulfilled the first four feasts during His first coming, and will fulfill the latter three feasts during His second coming.

The following are the four spring feasts that have already been fulfilled:

Passover = Jesus's crucifixion

The Passover in Egypt was observed by the Israelites painting their doorways with the blood of a sacrificial lamb in order to be "passed over" from God's wrath (Exodus 12:1-13). Likewise, Jesus was crucified on Passover, symbolically dying as the Passover lamb for the sins of the world so that we could be saved and not face God's judgment.

Feast of Unleavened Bread = Jesus was in the tomb

The Exodus of the Israelites out of Egypt occurred during this feast. The Jews traditionally made bread that was unleavened and would not rise.

Note that in Matthew 26:26, Jesus referred to the Passover bread as His body. Jesus' body remained in the tomb on the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, yet to be risen.

Feast of First Fruits = Jesus rose from the dead

During this feast, the Jews would offer up the first fruits of their harvest to God. Jesus rose from the dead as the first fruit of all who would inherit eternal life.



Pentecost = The Holy Spirit came to dwell within us

Also known by the Jews as the “Feast of Weeks,” this feast is marked as the end of a long waiting period. In Acts 1:4, Jesus told the Jews “that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father,” which was the blessing of the Holy Spirit. When the waiting period was over, the Holy Spirit descended upon the believers.

This event began the Church Age, or the era during which the church spreads throughout the world to share the Gospel and make disciples. The Church Age is also synonymous with the Age of Grace, occurring between the 4000th and 6000th year of God’s 7000-year plan.

The following are the three fall feasts that have yet to be fulfilled:



Feast of Trumpets = Rapture

The main way the Jews observed this feast is through the blowing of trumpets, which acted as a call for the people to assemble to hear the voice of God. The feast would only begin when the first sliver of the new moon was confirmed visible by two witnesses. Since the Jews were unsure of exactly when this would occur, they reserved two days to observe the feast and only initiated festivities on the day they sighted the new moon.

Because of this, the Feast of Trumpets is known as the “hidden day” or “the day and hour no one knows.” In Matthew 24:36 and Mark 13:32 where Jesus says to his Jewish disciples that “no one knows the day or the hour,” he is actually directly referencing this feast, which they would have understood in the context of Jewish tradition.

Notably, on the day of the feast, 100 trumpet blasts are blown, with the final trumpet referred to as “the last trump.” The last trump is referenced in 1 Corinthians 15:51-52 to signal the initiation of the rapture:

“Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.”



Day of Atonement = Jesus’ 2nd Coming to Earth

The Day of Atonement is considered the holiest day of the year to the Jews. This day is focused on repentance in the hopes of gaining God’s forgiveness for their sins.

In Exodus 34:29, Moses descended from Mount Sinai for the second time on the Day of Atonement with the new set of tablets inscribed with the Ten Commandments. When Moses returned to the children of Israel, “the skin of his face shone while he talked with

him.” This event foreshadows Jesus returning from Heaven to Earth in His glorified state at His 2nd Coming.



Feast of Tabernacles = Jesus lives among us on Earth

The Feast of Tabernacles is a great feast of celebration following the period of repentance during the Day of Atonement. For this feast, God instructs His people to construct temporary shelters (*tabernacles*) where they dwell for the duration of the feast. These shelters were temporary to signify that the people were still in the process of traveling towards their permanent home with God. This tradition foreshadows Jesus making his permanent home among us, His people, during the final 1000-year age. During this 1000-year age, all nations will celebrate this feast by going to Jerusalem every year, which is described in Zechariah 14:16-19.

70 Weeks of Daniel

Now that we have the necessary background information, we can dive into Daniel’s prophecy of 70 weeks, which narrows down the specific timeframe of the end time events to 7 years.

In Daniel 9:24-27, Daniel is given a prophecy about the 1st and 2nd Coming of the Messiah. To summarize, the prophecy states that there would be a total of 70 weeks. Recall from earlier that in Numbers 14:34 and Ezekiel 4:6, a day can refer to a year. If we apply this understanding here:

$$\begin{array}{ccc} \mathbf{1 \text{ week} = 7 \text{ days}} & \xrightarrow{\text{a day is to a year}} & \mathbf{7 \text{ years}} \\ \mathbf{70 \text{ weeks} = 490 \text{ days}} & & \mathbf{490 \text{ years}} \end{array}$$

Daniel 9:25 specifies that there would be 69 weeks (483 years) between the decree to rebuild Jerusalem and the time of Jesus’ crucifixion. We know from Nehemiah 2:1-8 and historical evidence that the decree to rebuild Jerusalem was given on March 14, 445 B.C. Counting forward 483 prophetic years from this date gives the following:

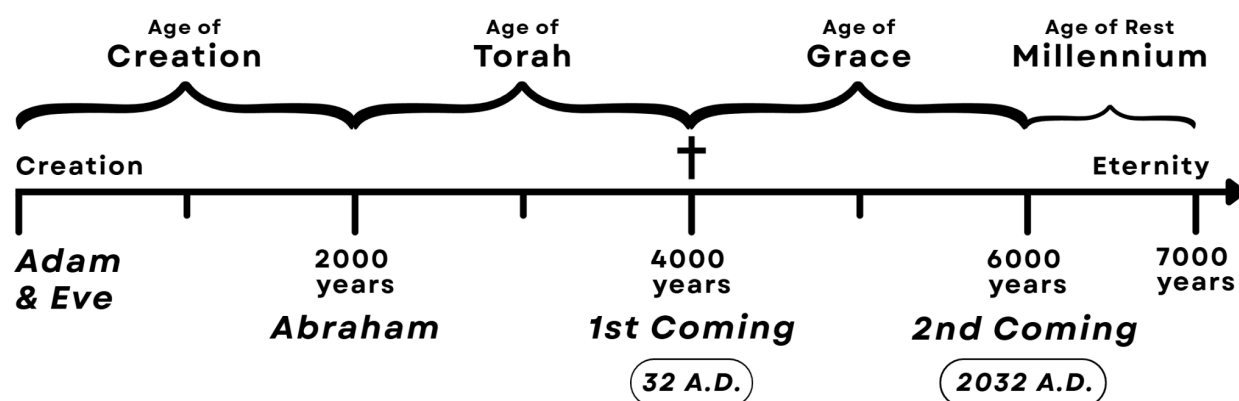
$$\mathbf{69 \text{ weeks} = 483 \text{ days}} \xrightarrow{\text{a day is to a year}} \mathbf{483 \text{ years}}$$

$$\mathbf{483 \text{ years} \times 360 \text{ days per prophetic year} = 173,880 \text{ days}}$$

$$\mathbf{March 14, 445 \text{ B.C.}} \xrightarrow{173,880 \text{ days}} \mathbf{April 6, 32 \text{ A.D.}}$$

Based on this, we can deduce that April 6, 32 A.D. was the approximate time that Jesus was going to be crucified on Passover, marking this as the 4000th year of God’s 7,000-year plan.

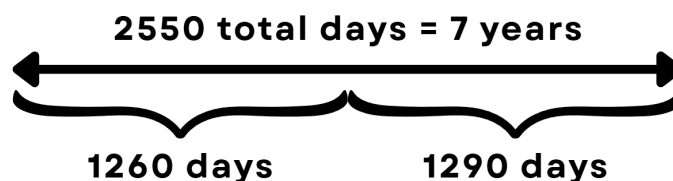
Now that we have established this date, we can count forward 2000 years to determine the 6,000th year and the 2nd Coming of Jesus to Earth. This lands the 2nd Coming of Jesus in the year 2032.



7-Year Tribulation

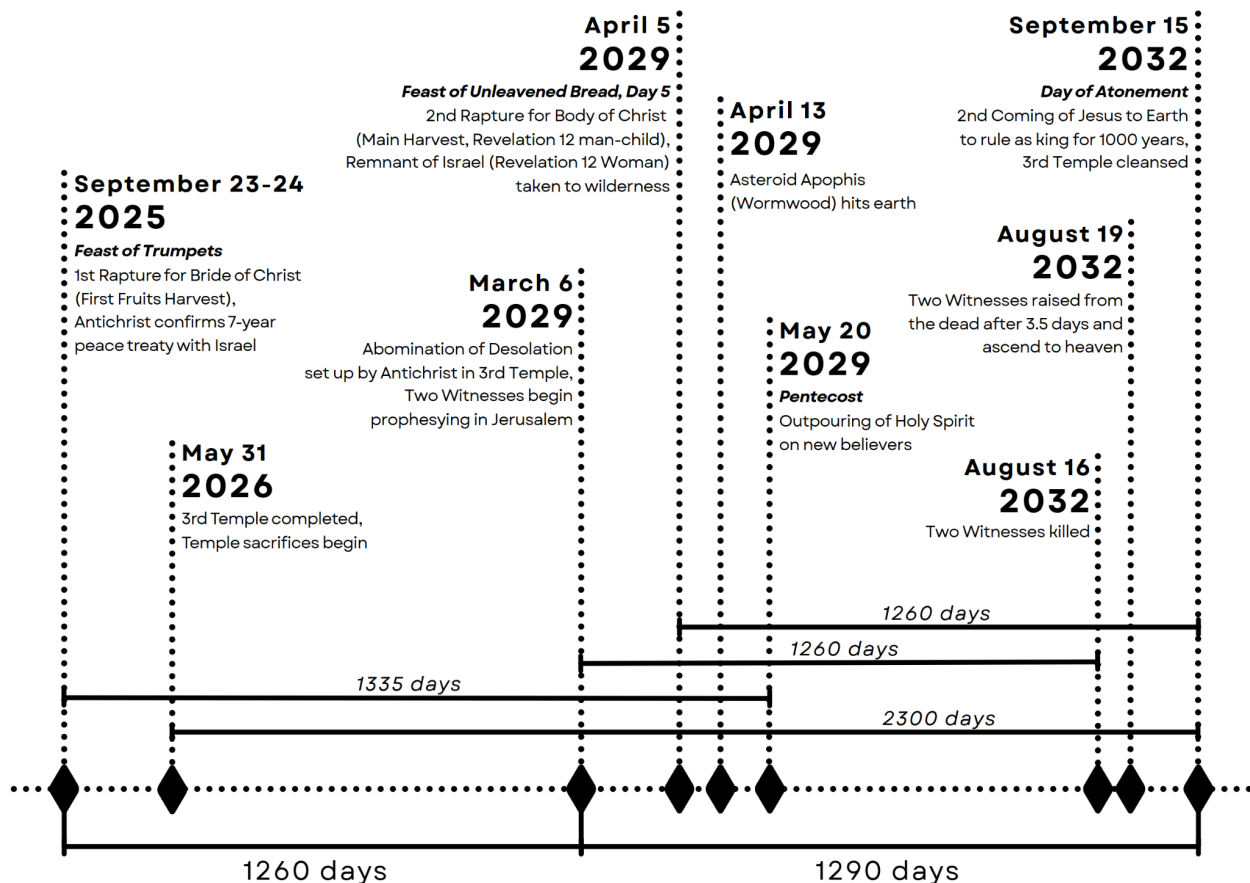
However, to determine exactly when the Rapture and Jesus' 2nd Coming occur, we need to examine the 70th week (*the final 7 years*) of Daniel's prophecy, which is also known as the 7-Year Tribulation. In the following section, the critical components of the prophecy will be laid out piece by piece and then put together at the end to form the final timeline.

1. It is commonly understood by prophecy scholars that the 7 years are bookended by the Rapture at the start and the 2nd Coming of Jesus at the end. Recall that the Rapture is linked to the Feast of Trumpets and the 2nd Coming is linked to the Day of Atonement.
2. The prophecy states that during the final 7 years, the Antichrist will confirm a covenant with many. In modern-day terms, I believe this means the Antichrist will put his stamp of approval on a 7-year peace treaty between Israel and many nations.
3. In the middle of the 7 years, the Antichrist breaks this peace treaty and turns on Israel by setting up the "abomination of desolation." The abomination will be some kind of sacrilegious act, likely some kind of idol, that will desecrate the soon-to-be-built 3rd Temple in Jerusalem. This event will divide the 7 years into two 3.5-year periods.
4. Revelation 11:3 and 12:6 specify that half of the 7 years is 1260 days, and Daniel 12:11 specifies that the 2nd half of the 7 years is 1290 days. Together, these day counts add up to a total of 2550 days, providing the exact length of the 7 years.



5. Daniel 12:12 mentions that people who wait to the 1335th day will be blessed. Recall that a period of waiting that culminates in the receiving of a blessing is linked with Pentecost.
6. Daniel 8:14 says that it will take 2300 days for the 3rd Temple to be cleansed.
7. Revelation 11:1-13 specifies that the Two Witnesses will speak prophecies for 1260 days in Jerusalem during half of the 7 years until they are killed. However, God resurrects them after 3.5 days and takes them to heaven.
8. Revelation 12:1-6 describes the Woman (*remnant of Israel*) who is pregnant and gives birth to the man-child (*Body of Christ or the Church*). The Church is taken to heaven (*2nd Rapture*) and the remnant of Israel is taken to the wilderness to a safe place that God has prepared for it for 1260 days.
9. Revelation 8:7-12 tells of an asteroid, referred to as Wormwood, that hits the Pacific Ocean and causes massive destruction to the earth. This asteroid has been determined to be the asteroid Apophis, which is scheduled to hit earth on April 13, 2029.

Now that all of the pieces of the prophetic timeline are laid out, the timeline can be assembled as follows:



I will briefly explain step-by-step how this timeline is created from the components above (a more in-depth explanation is available at www.youtube.com/watch?v=fTfiCu8Tn4g):

1. The 1st Rapture for the Bride of Christ (*First Fruits Harvest or Barley Harvest*), begins the 7-Year Tribulation on September 23-24 2025, during the Feast of Trumpets. This will occur at the same time as the 7-year peace treaty between Israel and many nations (Daniel 9:27).
2. The 2nd Coming of Jesus ends the 7-Year Tribulation on September 15, 2032 during the Day of Atonement, 2550 days after the 1st Rapture.
3. The 3rd Temple will be completed and the temple sacrifices will start on May 31, 2026, which is 2300 days (Daniel 8:14) counting back from the 2nd Coming of Jesus on September 15, 2032. Jesus will cleanse the 3rd Temple at His 2nd Coming.
4. The Abomination of Desolation is set up in the 3rd Temple by the Antichrist in the middle of the 7-Year Tribulation on March 6, 2029, which is 1290 days (Daniel 12:11) before the 2nd Coming of Jesus and 1260 days after the 1st Rapture.
5. The Two Witnesses start prophesying for 1260 days (Revelation 11:3) at the same time as the Abomination of Desolation is set up on March 6, 2029. They must start prophesying on this day because Revelation 11:2 mentions that Jerusalem will already be overrun by the gentiles (*non-Jews*), which should not logically happen until the Antichrist betrays Israel with the setting up of the Abomination of Desolation.
6. The Two Witnesses are killed after they finish prophesying for 1260 days (Revelation 11:7) on August 16, 2032.
7. The Two Witnesses are raised from the dead and ascend to heaven after 3.5 days (Revelation 11:11-12) on August 19, 2032.
8. The 2nd Rapture of the Body of Christ (*Main Harvest or Wheat Harvest of the Revelation 12 man-child*) and the fleeing of the Remnant of Israel (*Revelation 12 Woman*) to the wilderness for 1260 days (Revelation 12:6) occurs on April 5, 2029 during the Feast of Unleavened Bread. These events must occur on this day because they must happen during the final 1260 days of the 7-Year Tribulation. This is so that the Remnant of Israel is protected in the wilderness until the 2nd Coming of Jesus as their Messiah during the Day of Atonement on September 15, 2032. Recall that the original Exodus of the Israelites from Egypt to the wilderness occurred during the Feast of Unleavened Bread as well.
9. The asteroid Apophis (*Wormwood*) hits the Pacific Ocean around the middle of the 7-Year Tribulation on April 13, 2029.
10. Believers in Jesus who come to faith after the 2nd Rapture and reach the 1335th day (Daniel 12:12) after the 1st Rapture are blessed with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit during Pentecost on May 20, 2029, just like during the Pentecost of 32 A.D. The Holy Spirit will help them stand strong against the Antichrist and become martyrs for their faith (*Grape Harvest*, Revelation 14:14-20).

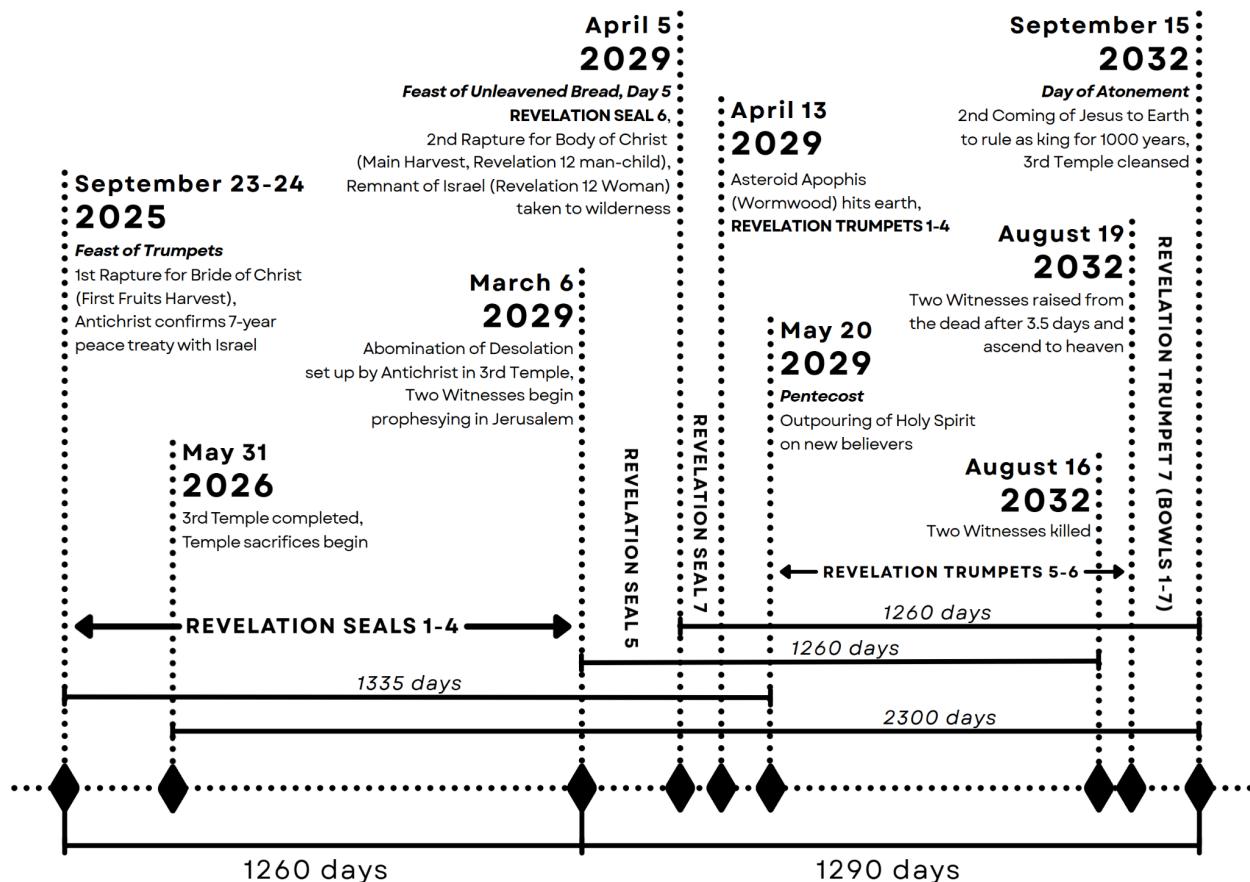
Seals, Trumpets, and Bowls of Revelation

To gain more insight into the events of the 7-Year Tribulation, we must look to the Book of Revelation. The book is generally laid out in chronological order, although not entirely. The easiest way to sequence the events of Revelation are by the 7 Seal, 7 Trumpet, and 7 Bowl judgments since they are numbered and ordered clearly. In the following table, I have summarized these judgments and briefly explained how they relate to the timeline of the 7-Year Tribulation that has been created above.

Judgments	Bible Verses	Description
Seals 1-4	Revelation 6:1-8	4 horses that bring a conqueror in white (<i>Antichrist</i>), war, famine, and death. Likely begins at the beginning of the 7-Year Tribulation on September 23-24, 2025.
Seal 5	Revelation 6:9-11	Short span of time during which Christians will be killed for their faith. Likely begins with the Abomination of Desolation and Antichrist proclaiming to be God (2 Thessalonians 2:3-4) on March 6, 2029. Lasts until the Seal 6 and Revelation 12 man-child rapture (<i>2nd Rapture</i>) on April 5, 2029.
Seal 6	Revelation 6:12-17 Matthew 24:15-31	A great earthquake and signs in the sun, moon, and stars. Jesus seems to imply that this occurs immediately after the tribulation caused by the Abomination of Desolation and happens at the same time as a rapture event. Likely is the same event as the Revelation 12 man-child rapture (<i>2nd Rapture</i>) on April 5, 2029. People who are raptured at this time are seen in heaven in the next chapter (Revelation 7:9).
Seal 7	Revelation 8:1	Silence in heaven for half an hour. Applying the “a day is to a year” principle, half an hour is equivalent to about 7.5 days, matching the period of time between the Revelation 12 man-child being raptured (<i>2nd Rapture</i>) on April 5, 2029 and the asteroid Apophis hitting the Pacific Ocean on April 13, 2029.
Trumpets 1-4	Revelation 8:7-12	A great mountain/star named Wormwood falls into the ocean and destroys a third of the world. Likely the asteroid Apophis hitting an ocean on April 13, 2029. The ocean is likely the Pacific Ocean since it is the only ocean that covers about a third of the Earth’s surface.
Trumpets 5-6	Revelation 8:13 Revelation 9 Revelation 11:14	Trumpet 5 (<i>1st Woe</i>) unleashes fallen angels or demons from below the Earth’s surface to torment people for 5 months. Likely begins after the outpouring of the Holy Spirit during Pentecost on May 20, 2029. Trumpet 6 (<i>2nd Woe</i>) is a massive war with over 200

		million soldiers involved, resulting in a third of the human population dying. Likely World War 3. Continues until the Two Witnesses are resurrected and taken to heaven on August 19, 2032.
Trumpet 7 (Bowls 1-7)	Revelation 8:13 Revelation 11:15-19 Revelation 16	Trumpet 7 (3 rd Woe) happens shortly after Trumpet 6 finishes on August 19, 2032 and initiates Bowls 1-6, which are terrible plagues. Armies of the Antichrist gather at Armageddon afterwards in preparation to fight Jesus at His 2 nd Coming. This is followed by Bowl 7, which destroys the world and splits Jerusalem into 3 parts, leading directly into the 2 nd Coming of Jesus on September 15, 2032.

Now that the Seal, Trumpet, and Bowl judgments have been laid out within the context of the timeline, we can overlay them directly on to the timeline to see how everything fits together:



Amazingly, all of the Seals, Trumpets, and Bowls of Revelation can be perfectly mapped out in chronological order on the timeline, reinforcing its credibility. Even the 7.5 days of silence in heaven during the 7th Seal slots in exactly between the heavenly events of the 6th Seal on April 5, 2029 and the asteroid Apophis falling from heaven as part of the 1st to 4th Trumpet on April 13, 2029.

Furthermore, Matthew 24 and the Parable of the Fig Tree also support this timeline precisely. Recall that, during the Parable of the Fig Tree in Matthew 24:32-34, Jesus specifically says, **“This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.”** What are **“these things”** that Jesus is referring to here? He is referring to the events that He talked about immediately before the Parable of the Fig Tree, namely the Abomination of Desolation (Matthew 24:15-28) and the events of the 6th Seal (Matthew 24:29-31). According to the timeline, these events finish by April of 2029, just before the generation of Israel’s rebirth passes and turns 81 years old in May of 2029 (*recall a generation is 70-80 years from Psalms 90:10*), thus fulfilling Jesus’ words perfectly.

As can be seen above, the 7-Year Tribulation, especially the 2nd half, will be a very terrible time to live through. In Matthew 24:21, Jesus Himself says, **“For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.”** I do not wish for any person to have to endure through this time, for it will be the worst time in the entire history of the world.

For those who read this document, especially those who do so before the 7-Year Tribulation begins, I plead with you to prepare your hearts before God by seeking a true relationship with Jesus and repenting from any sin that you indulge in so that you may escape all that is soon coming upon the earth. If you have been left behind after the 1st Rapture, make sure your heart is prepared as soon as possible but especially before the Abomination of Desolation is set up and the 2nd Rapture happens so that you do not miss your final opportunity to be raptured. If you have missed both the 1st and 2nd Rapture, you will likely need to prepare yourself to be martyred for your faith. Stay strong unto death and you will be rewarded greatly in heaven.

Warnings for Those Left Behind

Before I close out this document, I want to provide two important warnings to those who have been left behind. These are incredibly important, so please heed these warnings:

Alien Deception

When the 1st and 2nd Raptures happen, the governments of the Earth will need to explain why millions of people suddenly disappeared. They will be unwilling to tell the general public that Jesus took them because that would exacerbate the panic that is already spreading everywhere. To handle this situation, the governments will likely say that an alien invasion or intervention occurred. They have already prepared the public to accept this excuse through years of movies, tv shows, and other media portraying this happening while also gradually declassifying related intelligence documents on extraterrestrials.

The governments may tell the public that they are in contact with these extraterrestrials and are working on a way to bring back people's loved ones, particularly children, that went missing. Do NOT believe these lies and turn to Jesus instead.

Mark of the Beast

At some point during the 7-Year Tribulation, likely during the 2nd half, the Mark of the Beast will be implemented as part of a new worldwide economic system under the control of the Antichrist (Revelation 13:16-18). This Mark will be some type of image, code, or chip on or in your hand or forehead that will be required for people to be able to participate in this new economic system. Anyone without the Mark will essentially be cut off from the rest of society, being unable to buy or sell anything, resulting in starvation, lack of shelter, etc.

Although it sounds like you will need to take the Mark of the Beast to survive, you must ABSOLUTELY NOT take it for ANY reason. Revelation 14:9-11 makes it clear that any person who takes the Mark will never be able to receive salvation. Taking the Mark is equivalent to rejecting Jesus permanently. It would be better to die than to take the Mark.

If you find yourself still on the earth when the Mark of the Beast is implemented, I beg of you to resist taking this Mark and to cling to Jesus with everything you have. Only Jesus will be able to help you to endure through such great tribulation.

Conclusion

With this, I have laid out my case for the timeline of the end and the soon-coming Rapture and return of Jesus. Despite how difficult it may be to digest, I pray that God opens up your heart to understand what is coming.

To the one reading this, I understand that you may be feeling overwhelmed by what you have just read. I understand you may have many questions as you digest this. You may be wondering what you must do next with this information.

I urge you to prepare for His return, because He is coming soon. Prepare your heart and ensure you are walking with Jesus every day. Repent for what needs repenting and turn away from your life of sin. If you already walk with Jesus daily, share this information with those who are not yet ready. Help them to prepare for His return as well.

Despite the uncertainties that lie ahead, I remind you that Jesus is always watching over you and waiting for you to come home. Hold fast to His Word, as it will be the greatest comfort in the darkness ahead. For He is the Word, and to know the Word is to know Him. He is the way, the truth, and the life. Through Him and Him alone can we be saved.

“He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.”
